to Potty Animal Success

Our twin wallabies, Wally and Wiley, are learning to wee and woo in their new Wallaby Potty seat. When they were babies, they would go in their diapers and we would change them. But now Wally and Wiley want to be Potty Animals and learn to go potty on their own. So we are teaching them how by using the Wallaby's Five Easy Potty Animal Steps to Success.

STEP #1: Set Your Wee-Minder

To be a Potty Animal, you must learn to try to go wee or woo through-out your day and night, so you do not have an accident in your pants. That's why Wally and Wiley and the Wee-Minder gang have a Wee-Minder to help remind them to try to hop, hop, hop to The Potty Place. Since we are Wally and Wiley's parents, and want to help them be successful Potty Animals, we set their Wee-Minder to remind them to go potty.

STEP #2: All I Ask is That You TRY

All we ask Wally and Wiley to do is try. So, when their Wee-Minder starts to sing the hip-hop Wee-Minder song, they hop to the Potty Place! Then they pull down their pants, sit on their new potty seat, read their Wee-Minder Adventure book, and wait for some wee or woo to come out.

"I was a little scared of the potty at first, but it was made to fit my lil' wallaby bum and only Wally, my twin brother, and I can use it; so it is special." Wiley admits. "Sometimes I make pee, other times I make poo, and sometimes nothing comes out at all, but I have to try."

Also, have your mommy or daddy teach you how to wipe from front to back.

STEP #3: FLUSH it All Down; Watch it Go Round

When Wally and Wiley go wee or woo, they wipe from front to back, pull up their wallaby pants and we show them how to flush, flush, flush it all down. Watch, watch, watch it go round.

"This is one of my favorite parts. It is so cool how it all swirls around and makes a loud thundering noise." Wally shares.

STEP #4: Make Bubbles/WASH Your Paws

After Wally and Wiley flush, we show them how to make bubbles and clean their Potty Animal paws. This is very important to learn and practice every-time you potty, so you stay clean and don't stink or spread germs.

"It's fun to sing the Wee-Minder song while making bubbles. I like to see how many bubbles I can make." Wiley giggles.

STEP #5: Potty Animal's Jumpin' Jolly Wallaby HUG

The last and most important step of them all is to celebrate success like a Potty Animal. To be a Potty Animal you have to give yourself or someone else a Jumpin' Jolly Wallaby hug by crossing your arms and squeezing yourself tightly while jumping up and down and singing the hip-hop Wee-Minder song:

Hop, hop, hop to The Potty Place,

Hop, hop, hop to The Potty Place.

Put a big smile on your face,

And hop, hop, hop to The Potty Place.

When you get there try to wee or woo,

Sit there and wait to go pee or poo.

Won't it be great, you're doing it mate,

You're a Big Potty Animal now.

Then flush, flush, flush it all down,

Watch, watch, watch it go round.

Wash up your paws, and under your claws,

You're making us all so proud!

Hip-hip-hooray! It's a Great Potty Day! You're a Big Potty Animal now!
